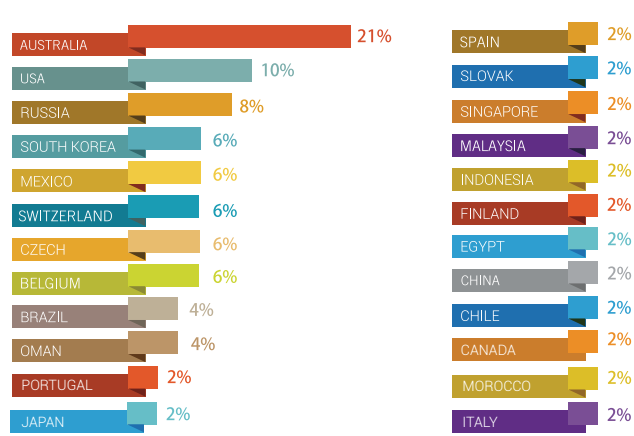

- Deadline for **May Session**: March 31, 2017. Exchange students must be nominated by home university before Feb 28, 2017.
